
## Student Climate Survey Results




Duke Law School's Diversity & Inclusion Committee developed and administered a climate survey in September 2020 to canvass the experiences of current Duke Law students. The survey conceived of diversity broadly so that the committee could better understand the views of the entire student body, including, but not limited to: race, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, gender identity, ideological viewpoint, socioeconomic status, veteran status, and ability status. A total of 428 students completed the web-based survey (123 1Ls, 140 2Ls, 147 3Ls, and 18 LLM and SJDs).

#### How satisfied are you with your Law School education?





## Overall, how comfortable do you feel at Duke Law School?





## Overall, how satisfied are you with the level of diversity in your classes?










